Advertisement for selection of Choreographer for conducting “Divya Kala Shakti – a Cultural Programme by Divyangjan” at Guwahati, Assam

Swami Vivekanand National Institute of Rehabilitation Training & Research (SVNIRTAR), DEPwD, MSJ&E, Govt. of India, is going to organize “Divya Kala Shakti – a Cultural Programme by Divyangjan” for the North-Eastern states i.e., Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura on 17.12.2022 at Guwahati, Assam. The main components of the programme shall be dance, song, instrumental music, stage drama, fine arts, pep talk, public speaking competition, recognition of sports persons, radio jockey, literature etc.

Applications are invited for selection of Choreographer for conducting the above programme based upon the following criteria.

- a) Should have a professional certificate in Choreography
- b) Minimum 5 years of experience in Choreography
- c) Should be competent in Choreography in contemporary, classical and folk dances
- d) Should have experience in Choreography in stage performance including combination of music and dance
- e) Should have experience in training Divyang children
- f) It is the responsibility of the selected Choreographer to arrange his/ her team for conducting the cultural programme by Divyang participants

Interested candidates are requested to submit their CV with photographs, experience and video clips about their programmes for selection to the email IDs: svnirtar.ind@gmail.com, crcguwahati@gmail.com on or before 27.11.2022. Divyang artists shall be intimated via email/ phone call to attend the selection meeting at Guwahati either in person or virtually on 29.11.2022. Finally, the selected Choreographer has to remain present during 01.12.2022 and 02.12.2022 at CRC, Guwahati for final selection of Divyang artists and then conduct the rehearsal and cultural programme at Guwahati along with team during 14.12.22 to 17.12.22.

It is also requested to quote rates for Choreography, providing training to the Divyang artists, finalizing the cultural items, coordinating with various participants/ teams, guiding the stage/ light/ sound/ video equipment providers during rehearsal and the final event, along with cost of Choreography team, which should include travelling, boarding, lodging and service charges of the entire team.

ABOUT THE EVENT :

The persons with disabilities (PwDs) especially youth/ children with disabilities have inner potential in performing art music, dance, sports and other recreational activities. However, many of them are deprived of getting opportunities to showcase their talent and skills. A need has been felt to create a platform to enable them to showcase their abilities in these fields, which will not only build self confidence among them and will create awareness among parents and public at large to showcase their abilities, rights and government schemes.

Towards this endeavor, the Department had organised two cultural evening programmes titled "Divya Kala Shakti: Witnessing abilities in Disabilities' on 18.04.2019 and 13.07.2019. While the first programme was held before Hon'ble President of India at Rashtrapati Bhawan Cultural Centre (RBCC), the latter was held before Hon'ble President of India, Vice President, Prime Minister, Speaker of Lok Sabha, Council of Minister, MPs, Secretaries of Government of India at Balayogi Auditorium, Parliament House Library Building, New Delhi.

In these programmes, about 150 youth/children with disabilities performed dance & music and left the dignitaries spellbound. Hon'ble President of India advised this Department to take this programme further to sensitize state authorities & other stakeholders to create better understanding across the country, through national/regional level as well as State level programmes.

The next event has been scheduled on 17th December 2022 at Guwahati with the same aims and objectives by inviting artists with disabilities from north-eastern states of India, the detailed application procedure along with application form are enclosed herewith for kind reference.
